Pathway Choices & Programs at Riverside

Graduate High School from Riverside

- Students can attend Riverside College to earn their high school diploma while at the same time working towards their future trade (Industry Training Authority Level 1 Foundation) or career training program, earning course credits towards graduation.

Attend Riverside after High School Graduation

- Additionally, students may enroll at Riverside College after they graduate high school to complete a trade (Industry Training Authority Level 1 Foundation) or career training program.

Most programs at Riverside College run 8-10 months, 5 days a week, beginning September of the school year. Our programs integrate both in class instruction and on the job training through our unique Work Study program, leading to opportunities for employment in the chosen field.
